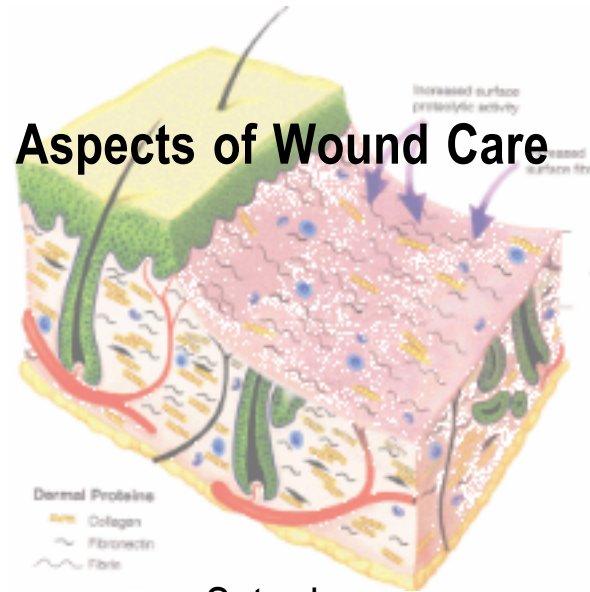
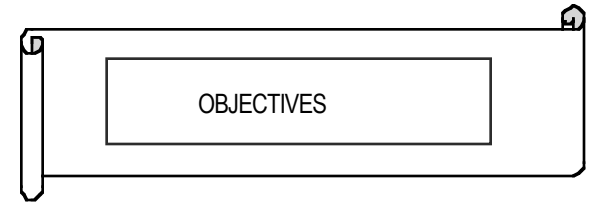



Directions

From I-696:


Exit at Greenfield and go south. Go to Nine Mile Road and turn right (west). Go to Providence Drive and turn left (south). Continue south on Providence Drive to the first traffic light and turn left into the Professional Medical Building (PMB) parking lot.

From the Lodge:

On southbound Lodge, exit at Nine Mile Road and turn left (east). On northbound Lodge, exit at Northland and take the Service Drive up to Nine Mile Road and turn right (east). Go east on Nine Mile Road to Providence Drive, and make a right (south). See underlined instructions above.

In the PMB:

Go around the first floor elevators (either to the right or left) to a corridor leading to the Hospital. Fisher Auditorium is through the double doors and to the left.
